We are excited that you have chosen to participate in the 2019 WFSC Spring Ice Show. We look forward to working with all of you to make this show a lot of fun and a big success. Please review the following regarding participation fees, rehearsals and costumes. To participate in the show, you must be enrolled in the current Learn to Skate session at the Ice Sheet. Sign and date this agreement and return to Amanda Kovar, Letitia Ahrensback or to the front desk at the ice sheet no later than Thursday, February 21, 2019. Please note that a \$10 late fee will be assessed to applications handed in past the February 21, 2019 deadline.

DATES AND TIMES: This year's show is scheduled for Friday April 26, and Saturday April 27, 7:30-9:00 p.m., followed by a "Skate with the Stars" public skate session from 9-10 p.m. All show participants are encouraged to "stay and skate" this session (in costume if possible) as we invite our audience to join us on the ice after both shows. The "Skate with the Stars" session will be advertised as part of the show, and included in the price of the ticket. Skate rental will be \$1.

GROUP NUMBERS: Group numbers will be assigned based on age and skating level. Skaters will be assigned to their group number at the Ice Show Launch Party on February 27 at 5:30pm. Music will be assigned to each group that fits with the theme and flow of the show. A coach will be assigned to each group number and will be your primary contact for all show-related questions. You may also contact the show coordinator Amanda Kovar or Letitia Ahrensback with questions about the Learn to Skate group numbers for the ice show.

PRACTICES: Your assigned Learn to Perform coach will notify you of your group's practice days/times. Please notify your group choreographer if you are unable to attend a practice. You may not miss more than one (1) group practice. Please plan to arrive early for practices so that you can be on the ice at the designated time.

COSTUMES: Costumes will be determined by the coach and members of each group. The skater is responsible for all costume costs. Every effort should be made to keep costumes affordable.

MANDATORY DRESS REHEARSAL: There will be one mandatory dress rehearsal for ALL SKATERS participating in the show. The rehearsal will be held on Wednesday, April 24, 2019 4:30-6:30. You are required to be ready to take the ice when rehearsals start. We cannot hold for anyone due to limited time.

FEES: All fees are included in your registration as outlined on the application. At the first meeting of your group, each skater will receive a punch pass to be used for any practice session occurring on freestyle or club ice. Each individual punch is only good for practice time. If you wish to skate before or after designated practice time this cost will be the responsibility of the skater. **Costume costs are additional and are the responsibility of each skater.**

PICTURE DAY: Photos for the show program will be taken the first week of rehearsals. Each group will be photographed together so it is imperative that all group members attend.

AGREEMENT**

I _____, Parent or Guardian of _____,

Understand that figure skating can be a challenging and dangerous sport and certify that my child is in reasonable health and that I will not hold the Wasatch Figure Skating Club responsible for any injury that my child may incur while participating in, or volunteering at or otherwise engaged in figure skating.

I also understand that I will not hold liable any member of the Wasatch Figure Skating Club, including its Board of Directors, for any injury incurred while engaging in figure skating.

I uphold the US Figure Skating Code of Conduct and am respectful to parents, coaches, rink staff and other skaters.

I understand that if I feel I need to make a claim against a member of the Wasatch Figure Skating Club for an incident that has occurred at a US Figure Skating Sanctioned event, including shows, test sessions, and competitions, the Weber County Ice Sheet, or at any Wasatch Figure Skating Club sponsored activity, I need to write and sign a formal complaint addressed to the Executive Board Members so that the US Figure Skating Code of Conduct, USFSA GR 1.02 may be enforced. I understand the difference between the Wasatch Figure Skating Club and Weber County Ice Sheet sponsored activities, but recognize that Wasatch Figure Skating Club members represent US Figure Skating at all times. I also understand that I am entitled to discuss the complaint with the presence of one or more Executive Board members in confidentiality but I may not discuss the complaint with anyone who is not directly involved with the situation. I also understand that gossiping and telling untrue things about Wasatch Figure Skating Club members will lead to my dismissal from and forfeit of funds paid to the Wasatch Figure Skating Club and I will be reported to US Figure Skating as a member not in good standing, which jeopardizes my continued eligibility and participation at all levels of figure skating
