LEARN TO PERFORM - PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

We are excited that you have chosen to participate in the 2020 WFSC Spring Ice Show. We look forward to working with all of you to make this show a lot of fun and a big success. Please review the following regarding participation fees, rehearsals and costumes. To participate in the show, you must be enrolled in the current Learn to Skate session at the Ice Sheet. Sign and date this agreement and return to Amanda Kovar, Letitia Ahrensback or to the front desk at the ice sheet no later than February 27, 2020. At Learn to Skate Bridge Night. A \$10 late fee will be assessed to applications handed in past the February 27, 2020 deadline.

DATES AND TIMES: This year's show is scheduled for Friday April 24, and Saturday April 25, 7:30-9:30 p.m., followed by a "Skate with the Stars" public skate session from 9-10 p.m. All show participants are encouraged to "stay and skate" this session (in costume if possible) as we invite our audience to join us on the ice after both shows. The "Skate with the Stars" session will be advertised as part of the show and included in the price of the ticket. Skate rental will be \$1.

GROUP NUMBERS: Group numbers will be assigned based on age and skating level. Skaters will be assigned to their group number at the Ice Show Launch Party on March 4 at 5:30 pm downstairs in the Penalty Box at the Ice Sheet. Music will be assigned to each group that fits with the theme and flow of the show. A coach will be assigned to each group number and will be your primary contact for all show-related questions. You may also contact the show coordinator Amanda Kovar or Letitia Ahrensback with questions about the Learn to Skate group numbers for the ice show.

PRACTICES: Rehearsals will be on Wednesday nights 4:30 – 5:30 depending on level. Your assigned Learn to Perform coach will notify you of your group's practice time once assigned. FEES: All ice time fees for practice are included in your registration as outlined on the application. If you wish to skate before or after designated practice time this cost will be the responsibility of the skater. Costume costs are additional and are the responsibility of each skater under the guidance of designated Ice show Coach.

PICTURE DAY:

Group Photos for the show program will be taken March 18, 2020 during club ice. Attendance is Mandatory individuals who do not attend will not be pictured in the program (named only). Due to time restrictions and printing times, no exceptions will be made. Skaters will not be in costume.

I uphold the US Figure Skating Code of Conduct and am respectful to parents, coaches, rink staff and other skaters. I understand that if I feel I need to make a claim against a member of the Wasatch Figure Skating Club for an incident that has occurred at a US Figure Skating Sanctioned event, including shows, test sessions, and competitions, the Weber County Ice Sheet, or at any Wasatch Figure Skating Club sponsored activity, I need to write and sign a formal complaint addressed to the Executive Board Members so that the US Figure Skating Code of Conduct, USFSA GR 1.02 may be enforced. I understand the difference between the Wasatch Figure Skating Club and Weber County Ice Sheet sponsored activities, but recognize that Wasatch Figure Skating Club members represent US Figure Skating at all times. I also understand that I am entitled to discuss the complaint with the presence of one or more Executive Board members in confidentiality but I may not discuss the complaint with anyone who is not directly involved with the situation. I also understand that gossiping and telling untrue things about Wasatch Figure Skating Club members will lead to my dismissal from and forfeit of funds paid to the Wasatch Figure Skating Club and I will be reported to US Figure Skating as a member not in good standing, which jeopardizes my continued eligibility and participation at all levels of figure skating.
