Please Note: We are still required by US Figure Skating to follow Covid -19 Protocols. Copied and pasted from their website.

*Effective August 2, 2021*

*Masks are required to be worn indoors by ALL people (including fully vaccinated people) attending any U.S. Figure Skating-sanctioned event or activity despite local, state or facility policies. Sanctioned activities include competitions (U.S. Figure Skating and Compete USA), exhibitions/performances and test sessions.*

*Exceptions:*

*Athletes practicing or competing on the ice.*

*Warming up outside.*

We are required to follow all US Figure Skating Rules and Policies to stay in good standing and maintain our sanctions as a club. Please take this into consideration before deciding whether to participate in the Spring Show.

Please review the following regarding participation fees, rehearsals, and costumes. Sign up will be online through Entryeze and MUST BE COMPLETED BY FRIDAY FEBRUARY 18, 2022. A \$10 late Fee will be applied after February 18. Applications will no longer be accepted after February 25, 2022.

#### **Ice Show Guidelines and Information**

All WFSC members are eligible to participate in the ice show. The below show fees DO NOT include ice time or costume fees. Music/song selections (Solo and Groups) will be made by the show directors that fits with the theme and flow of the show.

Show Fees: To be paid online at time of registration.

Production Number: Free

Solo: \$25

Step-out: \$20

Group number: \$35

Dress rehearsal: \$10 (Required)

#### **Production Group Number**

All WFSC Skaters may participate in the production number, for free in addition to their solos/step-outs/group numbers. Production number practices will be held on Wednesdays during club ice (March 9 – April 13). Once all applications are in, skaters will be notified of the official rehearsal practice times.

#### **Qualifications for a solo: (Pre-Preliminary w/Axel)**

- Soloists must be a WFSC club member in good standing.

- Skaters must have competed in Pre-Preliminary (W/Axel) or above level to have a solo. Well Balanced, Showcase, Excel WITH AXEL equivalent level).
- Soloists will be responsible to provide their own costume and must pay the appropriate pro fees for program choreography.
- Music will be assigned by Show Director.
- Soloists are to set a positive example to other skaters in their behavior and attitude.

#### **Qualifications for a step-out/Duet/Trio: (Non-Test, Pre-Pre Excel)**

- Skaters with Step-outs must be a WFSC club member in good standing.
- Skaters must have competed in No-Test/Pre-Pre Excel level or above to have a step-out.
- Step-outs will be responsible for their own costume and will meet with their own coach or plan lessons with group number coach at their own time and expense.
- Skaters must participate in all assigned group number rehearsals.
- Skaters are to set a positive example to other skaters in their behavior and attitude.
- Skaters may be assigned to a duet or a trio, depending on the number of skaters who qualify for a step-out.

#### **Group Numbers:**

- All WFSC skaters in good standing may participate in a club group number, in addition to Solo/Step-out.
- Skaters will be put into groups that reflect the theme and flow of the show.
- Groups will not be solely based on the level of the skater, but what fits best for the flow of the show.
- Group number assignments will be announced about a week after sign-up has closed.
- Costumes will be chosen by the assigned choreographer.
- Costume costs will be at the skater's expense.

#### **Group Rehearsal Information**

- Practices will begin in March. Specific dates and times will be scheduled by the choreographer assigned to the group number.
- Skaters should make every effort to attend every rehearsal.
  - Skaters are expected to be on the ice ready to go ON TIME.
  - Absences must be excused by assigned choreographers. Please contact your Choreographer if you know you will be missing a practice. (If your Spring Break dates conflict, please communicate with your choreographer to discuss participation as exceptions may be made.
  - Only one unexcused absence will be accepted at the discretion of the choreographer.
  - Skaters who habitually miss rehearsals or have two no show/unexcused absences may be asked to not participate in the Spring Show.
  - If a Choreographer feels that the group needs more rehearsal time, they may set up additional practice times.
  - Due to the nature of preparing for a production such as this, practice times may change. Any changes to the set schedule will be posted and emailed out to participants affected ahead of time. Please be sure to check your email and possibly even your spam folder for updates.
  - All skaters are expected to treat all other skaters and coaches with respect. Inappropriate behavior and poor attitudes will result in dismissal from the show. No reimbursements will be given if a skater is dismissed.

#### **Mandatory Dress Rehearsal:**

Mandatory rehearsal for ALL SKATERS participating in the show. Rehearsal will take place Wednesday, April 20, 2022, 4:30-6:30 p.m. Skaters are required to be ready to take the ice when rehearsal starts. We will not hold for anyone due to limited time.

## **Mask Mandate**

US Figure Skating requires all sanctioned events to follow a 100% mask mandate. Per their policies posted on their website as stated above. All participants, coaches, chaperones, spectators, volunteers, etc. are required to wear a mask at ALL times while inside The Weber County Sports Complex (Ice Sheet) during the Spring Show Performance, this includes during set up (before the show) and take down (after the show), all time designated as WFSC Show time (reserved time from the rink) and during Dress Rehearsal. Failure to comply with this rule will result in immediate dismissal from the facility. There will be NO exception to this rule. The Weber County Sports Complex (Ice Sheet) supports The Wasatch Figure Skating in their compliance with US Figure Skating and their Covid 19 policies.

## **Program Pictures**

Group Pictures will be taken during group practice by the assigned choreographer. Solo/Step-out skaters will need to submit a headshot/school photo to be included in the program.
