Please review the following regarding participation fees, rehearsals, and costumes.

Ice Show Guidelines and Information

All WFSC members are eligible to participate in the ice show.

The below show fees DO NOT include ice time or costume fees. Skaters are responsible for their own choreography, ice time and costumes.

Show Fees: To be paid online at time of registration.

Solo: FREE

Additional Duet/ Trio/Group number: \$10

Production Number: Free

Music

Music choices are first come, first serve. One music title per skater.

Solo Music time restrictions are based on competition lengths. (Short Program)

Group numbers: SS1 – No Test 1:40, Pre-Preliminary and up 2:10.

****Any music not cut to the designated length WILL NOT be accepted and will require a re-cut.****

Text your music choice to Show Director Letitia Ahrensback at 801-309-5817 as soon as you can. She will inform you if your choice is still available.

Production Number Information (Open to all club members/all levels)

Practices will be Fridays 4:30 – 5:30 beginning November 19 and run through December 17. (No rehearsal November 26) Production number will be medley style. First night of rehearsals skater will be grouped based on

age/ level of skaters participating. Skaters are expected to be on the ice ready to go ON TIME. Skaters will be responsible for their own ice time fees for that hour on the freestyle session.

Due to the nature of preparing for a production such as this, practice time may change. Any changes to the set schedule will be posted and emailed/text out to participants affected ahead of time. Please be sure to check your email.

All skaters are expected to treat all other skaters and coaches with respect. Inappropriate behavior and poor attitudes will result in dismissal from the show. No reimbursements will be given if a skater is dismissed.

Volunteerism

The Winter Exhibition presents many opportunities for volunteerism, which is a requirement for club membership. Our shows are made successful by a collaborative effort of parents, coaches, and skaters. Participation of all is needed and welcomed. Junior Club members are also encouraged to participate in show production, lighting, sets, choreography, and more.

Tickets

Each family will receive a chaperone ticket for the show (wrist band). Admission cost for the spring show is \$8.00 Adults \$5.00 youth 3 and under free.

Exhibition Agreement

Completing an online form is an agreement that the skater and parent have both read the entire application and will follow ice show guidelines. Both the skater and parent will do what they can to make this the best experience for everybody involved.

COVID-19 Policies

- Each competitor will be limited to 1 family member only accompanying skaters in the lobby/backstage.
- All other family members/friends may spectate the show from the stands following social distancing guidelines.
- Show participant, volunteers, coaches and spectators will be required by event staff to follow 6-foot social distancing guidelines.
- U.S. Figure Skating mandates that all persons entering the facility, must wear a mask and/or face covering while inside the facility. This includes show participant, volunteers, coaches, spectators wear masks and/or face coverings at all times.
- The one exception is that when a performer is on the ice no mask or face covering will be required for that performer(s).
- Performers, volunteers, coaches, and spectators will be asked to stay home if they have or are experiencing any of the following symptoms: DO NOT COME TO THE RINK! Cough, Trouble breathing, Shortness of breath, Sore throat, Sudden change in taste or smell, Fever/Chills, Unexplained muscle aches or pains, OR if they have been told to quarantine by local health authorities.

Use of Facility and Amenities

- Skaters are encouraged and recommended to arrive at the rink in full hair, makeup, and costume.
- Dressing rooms WILL NOT be available during the show. Skaters will need to change in the rink restrooms.
- Skaters will be required to adorn their skates in the lobby of the ice rink while maintaining social distancing guidelines.
- Skaters must wear a mask before and after skating. No exceptions please keep this in mind with regards to make up.
- Performers will follow social distancing guidelines while waiting to skate.
- Skaters will enter and exit the ice through separate entrance/exits.

COVID-19 Waiver and Release

COVID-19 is an extremely contagious virus that spreads easily through person-to-person contact. Federal authorities and the State of Utah recommend social distancing to prevent the spread of COVID-19. Contracting COVID-19 can lead to severe illness, personal injury, permanent disability, and death. Participation in Wasatch

Figure Skating Club (WFSC) programs could increase the risk of you or your child contracting COVID-19. WFSC and its Board/Coaches/Members undertake every effort to follow guidelines for a healthy environment; however as with any public event, we cannot guarantee that you will be 100% safe from airborne illnesses such as COVID-19 or colds and flu while participating in any WFSC programs.
